

BOURNSTREAM PLAY & PICNIC SITE - FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS - SITE RULES.

1. MEMBERSHIP.

The play site is **not** open to the general public.

Its dedicated use is for members/ keyholders - the children/young people with special needs for whom the Trust site was originally set up.

Members must **always** be accompanied by a responsible adult.

2. CHARGES.

An initial joining/one-off payment, for a key & pass number, is £10. These allow access to the Car Park, Entry to the Main Site & also use of the Toilet House.

Extra families who accompany you are asked to make a suggested donation of £2 per family in the box.

BIRTHDAY PARTIES can be held at a cost of £15...providing Mark Pasco has been notified in advance - by 'phoning him on (01453) 845568.

3. SAFETY.

The play site is **not staffed** & so keyholders must accept full responsibility for their own health & safety - & also be mindful of others using the site at the same time.

* NO GATE SHOULD BE CLIMBED OVER.

* **ALL GATES MUST IMMEDIATELY BE RE-PADLOCKED** afterwards.

* PADLOCKS must never be taken elsewhere or gates left open, eg. to await others/ latecomers. Please report any LOSS OF A PADLOCK.

The keyholder must personally admit any guests or latecomers.

* ANY DAMAGE on the play site must be reported asap on (01453) 845568.

* Childrens **HANDS SHOULD ALWAYS BE WASHED** after playing in the water or sandpit areas - there is hygienic gel available in several places.

4. ADULT SUPERVISION.

Every child must remain under the direct supervision of a responsible adult for their safety & behaviour - to ensure the child's actions do not endanger themselves or others.

5. CAR PARK.

Parking is in the car park only & must be kept clear of the entrance/wheel chair ramp.

Children must never be left alone in the car park or allowed to play there.

6. SITE BOUNDARIES.

The perimeter fence must not be climbed onto or over.

The play site extends from the car park up to the pond viewing platform.

All other surrounding land is private & should not be entered - including the **pond** which **has deep water**.

There is **NO** longer **access to the wood** from the playsite.

7. IN CASE OF ACCIDENT.

The nearest A&E for minor injury is at Berkeley (tel. 01453 562000) or Stroud (tel. 01453 562200) - Gloucester A&E is 0845 422 2222.

More serious accidents should be dealt with by a 999 call in the usual way.

8. FIRE HAZARDS.

Please do not smoke in the toilet house, on the veranda or in the gazebos.

Do not light any fires. Instant barbeques, in some areas, may be allowed by prior permission - for supervised parties only.

9. SITE SERVICES.

There are no litter bins - so users must **please take any rubbish away**.

There is no **safe** drinking water on the play & picnic site.

The toilet house has a septic tank, which is expensive to empty, so please only use as much water as you need - & ensure the tap is off.

10. PETS.

No dogs, except Guide Dogs, are allowed on site.

The donkeys come to the fence & can be fed with grass on a flat hand.

11. LOCAL SHOPS.

There is a good farm shop just up the Wotton road, on the right, Co-op/ Tesco's in Wotton itself or the village shop in North Nibley.

The above site rules are binding on everyone using the Bournstream facilities & authorised by the Trust Committee - their aim is to ensure a safe, secure & enjoyable experience for everyone.
